4. Graafschap Fire Department.

Graafschap Fire Chief Cal Haverdink reported a total of 21 calls in March 2 rescues were into Fillmore Township.

5. Fillmore Township Deputy.

Fillmore Township Deputy Ron Haverdink reported 28 calls in March. For 2008 the County responded to 590 calls and the Michigan State Police responded to 291 calls, for a total of 881 calls for service within Fillmore Township.
