# FILLMORE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES October 10, 2017 7PM

#### 1. Call to Order.

Supervisor Ken DeWeerdt called the meeting to order, Chuck Schaap with prayer and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

## 4. Graafschap Fire Department.

Fire Chief Doug DenBleyker reported;

- a. A total of 53 calls for September 2017. There were 5 fire calls, 7 medical/rescue, also 5 fire calls and 1 medical/rescue to other departments or agencies.
- b. The Township Board was able to inspect the new Engine 712 before the meeting. This is the first 4 wheel drive unit for the department. This truck should be in service by November 1, 2017.
- c. Deputy Chief Sara Bushee was present to explain a Fire Cadet/Explorer Program that the department wishes to establish. This program will help assure availability of competent well-trained individuals to consider for future fire department vacancies.
