Graafschap Fire Department.

Fire Chief Doug DenBleyker reported;

- A total of 68 calls for November 2018. There being 6 fire calls and 10 medical/rescue calls for Fillmore Township, also 6 medical/rescue call to other departments or agencies.
- A DNR Grant of \$3000.00 has been received this is a matching grant. A Skid Unit and Pump will be purchased with this Grant money.

A Motion was brought by Ken DeWeerdt and 2nd by Bob Yonker to approve the Consent Judgement Clarification as received from Ken Long representing Hidden Creek Community. PASSED 4-0.

Re: Consent Judgement Setback Clarification Sunrise Condo & Lease Lot Community. Considering Consent Judgement is not as clear as the Hidden Creek Community would like regarding auxiliary structure setbacks the appropriate parties/board have reviewed and approve pf the auxiliary structure setbacks on the condo sites and the eight site lease lot expansion sites being the same as that of which is currently approved by the state and utilized in the lease lot community; which is 10'. This will affect the trailers and condos that are back to back on Boulder Dr. Condos to be started in 2019.

a. Fillmore Township Planning Commission Minutes - November 19, 2018

Chapter 12, C-2 General Business District.

The first hearing was held to hear comments on a proposal to amend Chapter 12, C-2 General Business District by adding 12.03Q:

Light manufacturing and assembly of parts and products the Planning Commission considers to be consistent with the general character of general vicinity, to Section 12.03 Uses Permitted by A Special Use Permit.

Wording to be updated in the Fillmore Township Zoning Ordinance.

t. The second amends the Official Fillmore Township Zoning Map by rezoning approximately 30 acres in the South ½ of the Southeast ¼ in Section 25 from the A-1 Exclusive Agriculture District to A-2 Restricted Agriculture District.

The property being considered for rezoning in located at 48th St. and 138th Ave.

A Roll Call Vote was called: Ken DeWeerdt – YES. Leah Folkert – YES, Bob Yonker – YES and Elaine Mokma – YES.

12. Supervisor Updates.

Marijuana Resolution.

On November 6, 2018 the voters of the State of Michigan approved a ballot initiative which will permit the cultivation, processing and dispensing of cannabis and cannabis-infused edibles; however, the residents of Fillmore Township voted overwhelmingly 74% - NO and 26% - YES not to permit the cultivation, processing and dispensing of cannabis and cannabis-infused edibles for recreational purposes in the state;

A Motion was brought by Leah Folkert and 2nd by Bob Yonker to Adopted a Resolution not allowing the cultivation, processing and dispensing of cannabis and cannabis-infused edibles for recreational purposes in Fillmore Township, Allegan County, Michigan. The Fillmore Township Zoning Ordinance was adopted under the principles of permissive zoning (meaning only those uses listed in the ordinance are permitted).

A Roll Call Vote was called: Ken DeWeerdt – YES. Leah Folkert – YES, Bob Yonker – YES and Elaine Mokma – YES.
