4. Graafschap Fire Department.

Fire Chief Doug DenBleyker reported;

 - 2023 M-40 Road capital preventative Maintenance Reimink St. N to 52nd St. Single course chip seal.
- 2. At this time the M.A.C.C. has 1 employee Mara Gericke. Interviews for the Director position with the hope of having a new Director in place by early 2022 will soon begin.

Resurface: 140th Ave. from 56th St. to M-40 (2.75 miles)

c. 60th & Blue Star Hwy Street Light Request.

A request has been made by Fillmore Township to Consumers Energy for a streetlight at this intersection. The Township will be kept advised as to the progress of this installation.
