1. Call to Order.

Supervisor Ken DeWeerdt call the meeting to order Elaine Mokma opened with prayer and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

4. Graafschap Fire Department.

Fire Chief Doug DenBleyker reported;

- a. A total of 67 calls for December 2020. There were 12 medical calls, and 2 fire calls for Fillmore Township, there were 5 fire calls and 1 medical calls to other agencies.
- b. Chief DenBleyker gave a 2020 Year End Report with an increase of 9.1% in calls. Ending the year with 830 calls, 184 for Fillmore Township and 576 for Laketown Township.

Fire Board Chairman Bob Yonker reported;

a. Fire Board to meet on January 14, 2021 to begin the 2021-2022 Budget process.

5. Hamilton Fire Department.

Fire Chief Dave Haverdink presented;

a. The 2020 Annual Report which showed a total of 462 calls for 2020 which is an increase of 4% from 2019. The 2021-2022 Budget was also presented.

A Motion was brought by Bob Yonker and 2^{nd} by Chuck Schaap to approve the proposed budget for the Hamilton Fire Department. The Department has move to a July 1 – June 30 Fiscal Year for Budgeting purposes. The 2021 Operational Budget for the Interlocal Fire Department will be January 1, 2021 to June 30, 2021 – a 6-month Budget and a July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 – a 12-month Budget. Fillmore Township's share to be \$83,476.25 – 13%.
