OUTDOOR SALES OF OPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES

An ordinance to secure the public peace, health, safety, welfare and convenience of the residents and property owners of Fillmore Township, Allegan County, Michigan by the outdoor sales of operable vehicles.

The Township of Fillmore, Allegan County, Michigan ordains:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to place on, or to permit to be placed on any platted or unplatted parcel more than one (1) operable motor vehicle for sale at any one time.

SECTION 2. Any motor vehicle being dismantled for the sale of parts therefrom or any motor vehicle which has main component parts missing or unattached shall be considered inoperable for the purpose of this ordinance. Inoperable vehicles must be stored within a completely enclosed building.

The presence of a dismantled, partially dismantled or inoperable motor vehicle or parts of a motor vehicle, on any platted or unplatted parcel of land, not in accordance with this ordinance shall be considered a violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. The purpose of these regulations is to limit and restrict the number of motor vehicles displayed on any platted or unplatted parcel in Fillmore Township.
